The History of Modern-Day Israel with Bill Federer – Part 2

(January 9, 2023)

FRANK:

Ladies and gentlemen, if you're just tuning into this podcast and did not listen to the last one, we did with Bill Federer, you're going to be lost. You've got to go back and listen to the podcast we just did on the modern state of Israel. We're continuing it right now, on the midweek podcast. Bill gave us a lot of history leading up to the founding of modern-day Israel in 1948, and we're going to pick it up right where we left off. For those of you that don't know, Bill Federer, has a great ministry. His website is AmericanMinute.com. He's written several books. He is just an amazing historian who can tell a story about how all this came together for modern-day Israel.

Bill, in the last program, we covered a lot of ground. We were just getting up to the founding of the modern state of Israel in 1948. The Brits who had control over the area from 1917 on, were kind of fed up trying to negotiate between Jews and Arabs in that land. And there was a bit of an Arab Revolt between 1936 and 1939 in the land. There were many Jews coming back to the land, because there was antisemitism going on in Russia, Ukraine, Europe. And people were trying to escape this persecution that they were having. And the Brits really didn't want to deal with it.

So, the UN basically established the boundaries of Israel, and it became a state in May of 1948. And pretty much the next day, there was war. Now, Bill, how did these people who by about that time, there were, I guess, somewhere around five or 600,000 Jews in Israel by about 1948. Now there's about a little over 7 million Jews in Israel. How did they have an army ready to fight five different countries the day after they were founded? How did this happen?

BILL:

They were courageous. And then you did have some Americans on their own going over there and helping to organize them. They were using antiquated weapons left over from World War I. But it was just a miracle that they were able to survive. But it was a tremendous amount of courage. It stands as one of the modern day miracles of Israel, a nation that had not been in existence for nearly 2000 years, suddenly coming back and being born in a day.

FRANK:

Well, let me ask you about that, because Jews for many years had been going over there buying land, and establishing little communities. And they also were able to figure out ways to farm traditionally unfarmable land and create a lot of economic activity over in that area. And then, as 1948 approached, there were four different things that could have happened to Palestinians in certain areas. Palestinians could have stayed. In fact, the Prime Minister, the first Prime Minister of Israel, Ben Gurion, invited them to stay. And then some of their property was bought by Jews. Some of them left because Arab countries said, we're going to war, and you don't want to be caught in the crossfire. So, get out of the country.

They warned their Arab neighbors. And according to some of the accounts I've looked at Bill, about 600,000 Arabs left what we now call Israel. The question is, how many were forced out? Do we know that number? How many were forced out by Jews coming in or by warfare? Because that's really where the rub is. That's really right now where people are trying to say, oh, those people were forced out of their homes. They deserve to have their homes back. What's the truth of that?

BILL:

Israel just defended itself and they were being attacked. There was the message sent from Egypt saying that the day of the liberation of the land is at hand. They told me the Arab population to leave. And then once they wipe out the Jews, they could come back, and they could have all that land. So, they voluntarily left and went into the surrounding countries. Now, America assimilates people from other countries all the time. You have Vietnamese boat people. You have, you know, people from Africa, people from Latin. We assimilate them. Well, the surrounding Arab countries did not want to assimilate the Arabs that had come out of Palestine, because they wanted to keep them as an international pawn with which to use to reclaim that land, because they wanted to get rid of Israel.

Back to the Muslim Brotherhood back to the Wahhabi teaching. The Wahhabis goal is to have a one-world Islamic State. They call that a caliphate. They want a one-world government that's Muslim. That's the goal of the caliphate. And the word Muslim means one who has submitted. Islam means submission. And they think there'll be world peace when the whole world submits to the will of Allah. A moderate Muslim thinks the world is going to submit to Allah later. The fundamental Muslim thinks the world is going to submit to Allah now. Now the dilemma for the West is when the non-Muslim world shows itself strong and wins battles, well, then the Muslim world goes into remission. And they say, well, the world is going to submit to Allah, but it's going to have to wait until later. But when the non-Muslim world shows itself weak, then the fundamentalist says hey, it's happening. It's going to submit now rather than later. And it's like ringing a bell.

The more the non-Muslim world shows itself weak, the more the fundamentalist Muslims become more aggressive. It's sort of like the law of the jungle. But anyway, back to Israel. So, after World War I, the Ottoman Empire was gone, and the Muslim populations began to westernize. But then you had 1924, the British let the Wahhabi take over Arabia. In 1938, oil is discovered in Saudi Arabia. And now the Saudis, which were the most violent, backward Muslim country, with chopping off arms, and legs, and female genital mutilation, and all kinds of backwards stuff. Even to this day, in Riyadh, they have chop, chop square. I've talked to soldiers that have been there. And they said, yeah, I saw a woman get beheaded. And I saw another one.

You know, if a woman is seen with a man who is not a relative, the woman is accused of rape. And in Islam, when a woman is raped, she gets punished for allowing herself to be used as a tool of Satan to tempt the man. So, the women have to wear the burka to look unattractive on

purpose. Because if they look attractive, and they get raped, it's their fault for tempting the man. So, they get whipped 100 times, and it's totally backwards. There's a Supreme Court Justice Jackson, and he said that Middle East law is the antithesis of Western law. So, we punish the raper. They punish the victim of the rape. And so, anyway, 1928 the Muslim Brotherhood is started by six employees of the Suez Canal Company, Al-banna. And they come up with his two-step strategy of infiltrating countries and pretending to be moderate Muslims. Like Mohammed was originally a religious, moderate Muslim in the city of Mecca, but then transitioned to becoming a political Muslim, like Mohammed did when he moved into Medina.

And so, you begin to have all these Middle Eastern countries be infiltrated by Muslim Brotherhood people. And then the Muslim Brotherhood with Al-Khattab, began to spur off. And these other groups, the Wahhabis, excuse me, the Al-Shabab, the Boko Haram in Africa influencing the al-Qaeda and the Taliban, and the Khomeini in Iran. But all of those got their inspiration from the Muslim Brotherhood, who put in this two-step plan of the Wahhabi teachings that they want a one-world government that's Islamic.

FRANK:

This is why, ladies and gentlemen, you're not going to find in the so-called negotiations between, say, Israel and Hamas, or any of these other groups, you're never going to find Muslims agreeing to land for peace, because it's in their charter. In fact, let me just read something here from the Hamas charter. This is article 13 of the Hamas charter. "There is no solution for the Palestinian question except through Jihad. Initiatives, proposals, and international conferences are all a waste of time and vain endeavors." In other words, they are not open to land for peace.

This really doesn't have anything to do with land, does it Bill? It goes back to the ideology of Wahhabism, the ideology of jihad, the ideology of if you don't see it my way as a Muslim, I'm going to kill you because I need to bring Islam to the peak of the government, and everybody must submit to Sharia law. Unless you agree to submit, and that's what Islam means, submission. There will be no peace. So, this really isn't about land at all. Is it, Bill?

BILL:

No. And if Israel goes, it would be a tremendous encouragement that it is happening now rather than later. And you can be guaranteed that coming across the southern border, you have lots of Muslim terrorists as well. Now, one of the things that I need to point out here, after World War II, you had European countries piecing themselves back together again. And they started republics. And India, in 1947, was given its independence, and it's now its own country. And Egypt, and all these countries are all happy that World War II is over, and they're putting themselves back together until the KGB. And so, the KGB doesn't want these countries to be republics that are free and in the orbit of America.

They want to take them over. And so, the KGB does what's called Critical Theory, critical race theory, critical economic theory. They would observe a country and see all the groups ethnically:

Bosnians, Croats, Serbs, economically, racially, socially, religiously, Orthodox, Sunni, Shia. They really don't care what the groups are. They would identify some as victims and others as oppressors, haves and have nots. And then they would organize protests that they would whip into violent riots. And once you get into a riot, then people think emotionally and not logically. My friend was killed, I don't want to sit down and talk. And then they would co-op the media to blame the leader of the new republics for all of the crises. And when the public opinion turned against the leader, then they would do a coup or rigged election, and they would replace a leader with a Soviet puppet.

And so, this was being implemented after World War II. And you had the KGB started FARC in Colombia, with the help of Castro. And Brezhnev and Khrushchev helped Castro to take over Cuba from Juan Bautista. And then the KGB helped Che Guevara start ELN in Bolivia and start liberation armies. Wherever you see liberation army, that's KGB. They would start them in Africa in the Congo. Well guess what? In early 1960's, they started the Palestinian Liberation Organization. It's a KGB group. And they got a leader of it, Yasser Arafat, who was the nephew of the Mufti of Jerusalem, who made the deal with Hitler. And so, now you have a combination of very potent ingredients. You have fundamental Islam that hates the Jews, and wants a one world government, mixed with communist tactics.

And so, now you have this, not just Muslim Brotherhood infiltrating, but you now have the KGB tactics of infiltrating, breaking a country into groups, and then pitting the groups against each other to cause these internal crises. And then you can destabilize the country. And then you can take over. And so, the KGB started the PLO for the purpose of sowing division. That's the very purpose of its existence, is to sow division in the Middle East so it will not become pro West and pro America. Now, we sort of hung on to Saudi Arabia in a strange way. Because when FDR was on the USS Quincy in 1945 and he met with the King of Saudi Arabia, they did a secret oil security agreement, where Saudi Arabia agreed to sell oil to America, if America would build a military base and defend Saudi Arabia. And FDR agreed to that.

And so, from that time on, Saudi Arabia, which was one of the biggest oil producers, agreed to sell their oil in US dollar denominations. It's called the petro dollar. And since they were so big, all the other oil-producing countries sold their oil in US dollars. And it bolstered our American economy. And they did the Bretton Woods Agreement, that all oil is going to be sold in US dollars. And that is what was shaken with Biden, snubbing the King of Saudi Arabia. And then Saudi Arabia has now agreed to sell oil in Chinese Wan, and all these other different things. So, we're seeing the ending of this international oil for security secret agreement that FDR did. But in the meantime, every time we were buying oil, we were helping to finance the spread of Wahhabism.

So, in America, we go up. We fill up our gas tanks 1950's, 1960's, 1970's, and we're buying oil from Saudi Arabia. They're using that money to export Wahhabism. And since Saudi Arabia is where Mecca is, and Mecca is where the Hajj is, that's one of the five pillars of Islam. And once in your life, you're supposed to go on a pilgrimage to Mecca. Now under the Sharif of Mecca,

who was a modernist, it was more of a traditional thing. But after 1924 with the Wahhabis and the Sauds controlling Mecca, Muslims from around the world would go on their pilgrimage Hajj, and they would get infected with Wahhabism. And then they would come back to their countries and say, hey, we're a poor country. You know how to get really blessed? Look at Saudi Arabia. They are super fundamental, and they are super rich. If you want to be rich, you've got to be fundamental Muslim.

FRANK:

The prosperity gospel of Islam. There it is.

BILL:

Yeah. But it is a fascinating period, because you did have leaders that wanted to be moderate. And I mentioned Ataturk in Turkey. And he set up a secular state. And he banned the calls to prayer. He banned the fezzes and the burkas. He moved the weekend from Friday to Saturday and Sunday. He got rid of Arabic letters and Turkish letters and used the Latin letters. And he did keep Turkish, but he was moving in a western direction. And then the Shah of Iran, he's meeting with Kennedy, and Truman, and Eisenhower. And you see pictures of Iran in the 1960's and 70's. It looks like Southern California and the Beach Boys. Afghanistan, there's pictures of girls with their skirts going to college, carrying their books in Syria. There's pictures of beauty pageants taking place.

And then you have Nasir in Egypt. And Cairo was like, you know, Southern California. It was like, there's pictures of girls in their swimsuits on the Cairo beaches. And Gamal Nasir in 1958, spoke at a political event. And he said, I met with the head of the Muslim Brotherhood, and he sat with me and made his requests. What did he request? To make wearing the hijab mandatory in Egypt, and demand that every woman walking the street wear a tar headscarf. I told him, my opinion is every person in his own house decides for himself the rules. And he replied, no. As the leader, you are responsible. I told him, sir, you have a daughter in the school of medicine. She is not wearing a tarha. If you're unable to make one girl who's your daughter where the tarha, you want me to put a tarha on 10 million women myself [audience laughter]?

And so, this was the attitude. These leaders in these countries dressed in business suits, shaved, and they wanted to be friends with the West until the Muslim Brotherhood came in and began infiltrating, and threatening, and killing these leaders. And then you mix in the communists working together with the Muslim Brotherhood, bringing their liberation organizations to sow this division, because they don't want countries being pro West. They want them to be in their orbit. And then you throw in globalists. So, we used to, you know, World War I, up until World War II, we had a foreign policy that was pro America.

After World War II, FDR put a lot of socialists, a lot of globalists, one-world government type people into government positions. And so, the CIA and these different groups from World War II on, have been working two different foreign policies, one that the people in America thinks that we have. But on the other side, they're working a subversive globalist agenda. And the

globalists want international crises so that they can swoop in with their answers. And so, this is a part of the ingredient there. But I did want to throw in that the word Palestine, prior to 1962 when the PLO was started, the word Palestine was always associated with the land of Israel. There was the United Palestine appeal in 1925. And it had a poster, "Palestine, land of Jewish immigration and colonization. Help the wanderer return back to his own soil." And you had Franklin Roosevelt meeting with the head of the United Palestine Appeal. And his name was Rabbi Stephen Wise. And he, he was a moderate.

Stephen Wise started the NAACP, and he helped start the ACLU. And Steven Wise even did a sermon that got a lot of attention. He says that Jesus was a Jew, and rabbis should be quoting Him as a really good Jewish teacher. But Stephen Wise was the head of what? The United Palestine Appeal. And he got a letter from FDR saying, I'm so excited about the United Palestine Appeal. And the people in America are happy to help Israel go back to its homeland. And then you have even Golda Meir, and she's meeting with Nixon. And she gives a statement. And she said that there wasn't even a Palestine. I'll read the quote here, because she says that we didn't displace anybody out of the land.

It's June 15, 1969, Golda Meir, she's meeting with Richard Nixon. And she said, there was no such thing as Palestinians. When was there an independent Palestinian people with a Palestinian state? It was either southern Syria before the first World War, part of the Ottoman Empire, or it was Jordan, right? Because Jordan under Abdullah got control. And Golda Meir goes on. It was not as though there was a Palestinian people in Palestine, considering itself a Palestinian people, and we came and threw them out, and took their country from them. They did not exist. It was the Ottoman Empire.

FRANK:

And that's what people don't get, Bill. They don't know their history. They don't know that there was no such place as Palestine. They don't know that there are 400 million Arabs around the state of Israel with miles, and miles, and miles of land, thousands of miles of land, compared to Israel (which is what about size of New Jersey). And yet, the people who are claiming to be refugees from the land of Israel, who are claiming that their land was taken from them, none of those countries want any of those people.

I don't see how people miss this. I don't see how people miss the fact that if you read the Hamas charter, they're all about killing Jews. They're not about land. They say right in their charter that this is not about land at all. Article seven of the Hamas charter says the Day of Judgment will not come until Muslims fight the Jews. Article eight says Allah is its target. The prophet is its model. The Quran is its constitution. Jihad is its path, and that death for the sake of Allah is the loftiest of its wishes.

I've already read that article 13 says, forget about all these proposals for land. And yet, people over here are still trying to say that the solution to all this is some sort of two-state solution. Yet every time a piece of land is offered, it is rejected without even a counteroffer, Bill. How do

people miss this? And why are we so blind to think that when these people claim it's not about the land, we keep saying it's about the land? If we just give them land, everything's going to get solved. Why don't we see this, Bill, in America? Why don't we get it?

BILL:

A lot of people are uneducated, and they have learned that all you have to do is control the narrative. If you can control what the mainstream media says and what the colleges say that most people have a low intelligence level. They just want to be accepted by their group. And so, if it looks like the group is moving in this direction, they'll go along with it. But education is the first step. You know, FDR, he wrote in 1937 a letter to Stephen Wise, the rabbi who was the head of the United Palestine Appeal. And this is FDR.

It says, Dear Dr. Wise, please convey my good wishes to the National Conference for Palestine, which has been summoned by the United Palestine Appeal. The American people have watched with sympathetic interest, the effort of the Jews to renew in Palestine, the ties to their ancient homeland, and to reestablish Jewish culture, the place where for centuries they flourished and from whence it was carried to the four corners of the world. This year marks the 20th anniversary of the Balfour Declaration, the keystone of contemporary reconstruction activities in the Jewish homeland. These two decades have witnessed a remarkable exemplification of the vitality and vision of the Jewish pioneers in Palestine. It should be a source of pride for the Jewish citizens, the United States, that they too have a share in his great work of revival and restoration. And it's signed Franklin D. Roosevelt.

I mean, 1937, Palestine was the land for the Jews. And then you have 1948, and you have President Truman. And he is the one who recognized Israel and had the United Nations recognize Israel. And so, the 1948 Democrat party platform, this is their party platform. It says, President Truman, by granting immediate recognition to Israel, led the world in extending welcome to a people who have long sought freedom. We've pledged full recognition to the State of Israel. We affirm to the State of Israel the right of self-defense. And so, this was the Democratic party platform in 1948. And now, you got the squad, Elon and all these different ones. And then there's some interesting quotes.

So, Abdullah, who was the king of Jordan, he welcomed the Jews back. And it's so eye-opening to read these quotes because you think, gee. All these Arabs hated the Jews. But he writes about how it was in Europe that the Jews were treated bad. So, this is King Abdullah. This is in 1948. He writes this in the American Magazine. He says no people on Earth have been less antisemitic than the Arabs. The persecution of Jews has been confined almost entirely to Christian nations in the West. Jews themselves will admit that never since the Great dispersion did Jews develop so freely and reach such important as in Spain when it was an Arab possession. With very minor exception, Jews have lived for many centuries in the Middle East in complete peace and friendliness with their Arab neighbors.

And that was Abdullah. He was the son of the Sharif of Mecca, who worked with the British to defeat the Turks. Another son was King Faisal, King of Iraq. And he writes this in 1919. We feel the Arabs and Jews are cousins. And having suffered similar oppressions at the hands of power stronger than themselves, we look with a deepest sympathy on the Zionist movement. We wish the Jews the most hearty welcome home. And then you have the dad, the Sharif of Mecca in 1918.

He writes, the resources of the country are still virgin soil and will be developed by the Jewish immigrants, that the country is for its original sons for all their differences, a sacred and beloved homeland. And so, here you have these they're called Hashemites. That was the name of the family tribe that the sharif belonged to, which was the same tribe that Mohammed belonged to. And the Hashemites controlled Mecca and the holy places since the 10th century on. And he was a modernist, and he was a get along type of guy. And so, these were Arabs. There's pictures of Chaim Weizmann with King Faisal, of Iraq. And so, they were not enemies. The enemy was this Wahhabi teaching.

FRANK:

Yeah, I was going to say. These are the moderate Muslims, Bill, that would say, yeah, we can get along. But the Wahhabis won't have any part of it. And the Wahabis now are really controlling the Muslim Brotherhood. They're controlling Hamas. They're controlling, I would assume Hezbollah. These are the radicals who will kill other Muslims too, in addition to killing Christians and Jews. Am I correct?

BILL:

And they're doing it with our money, given to them by globalist leaders.

FRANK:

How many of these weapons, Bill, have found their way? The ones that Biden left in Afghanistan two years ago, how many of these weapons have now found their way into this conflict being used by Hamas on Israel? Do we know?

BILL:

It's strongly suspected that a lot of them are there. Even Marjorie Taylor Greene was asking that very question. But here you had a globalist, the Rockefellers, Standard Oil Company. They have JP Morgan Chase, the Rockefeller. They donated the land for the UN building. The Rockefellers, they're globalists. And with their Standard Oil Company, they were pumping money into the Wahhabi, Saudi Arabia, so they could spread this. But let's take it a little bit more recent. The Shah of Iran, he loved America. I actually went to college with some Iranian students. They had an American flag on their dorm room wall. I hate to admit it. In college, I did not have an American flag.

And these Iranians loved America. And the Shah wanted to secularize Iran, very similar to Ataturk secularizing Turkey. And the Shah had communists coming in, organizing, doing their

critical theory, and organizing the groups. And they would actually have communist soldiers dressed in Iranian uniforms and committing terrorist attacks so it could be blamed on the Shah. So, like the January 6th insurrection, where you have FBI agents going into bushes and putting on Trump shirts and coming out and then having riots, and then it gets blamed to Trump.

And so, you had the Jimmy Carter, rather than coming to the rescue of the Shah, abandons the Shah. His National Security Adviser, Zbigniew Brzezinski, whose daughter Mika does the TV news show. Anyways, Zbigniew Brzezinski helped orchestrate the abandoning of the Shah, the American friend, so that the Ayatollah could take over Iran and bring in his fundamentalism. And what did he do? He started Hezbollah.

FRANK:

Gee, that worked out for us, didn't it?

BILL:

And so, he starts Hezbollah in Lebanon. And what happens in Lebanon? You have the US Marine barracks blown up by Muslim terrorists, and connected with the Muslim Brotherhood, connected with Iran, connected with Al Khattab and all these different violent groups. And Reagan, I loved him. But his response was to pull America out. I actually talked to some military people saying that Reagan wanted to send our military in there, but the military refused. Anyway, but we looked like a paper dragon. You blow up a military base, America tucks tail and runs. We abandoned our friend, the Shah, and America just runs. We just abandon him.

And then you had an interesting, Soviet. So, we always think of two sides. There's always three, and actually four, because now you've got China and it's sending stuff over to the Middle East (weapon wise). But the Soviet Afghan War in 1979, the big enemy is the Soviet Union. And we have our CIA. It's the largest covert operation in our history up to this point. Covert means nobody in America knows about it, but the CIA is doing it. I know it's hard for people to think that that kind of stuff happens. But it's called Operation Cyclone. And we are arming and training the Taliban. We're literally giving them our best weapons.

And it was such a big deal that Sylvester Stallone did a movie on it called 'Rambo III.' And Tom Hanks and Julia Roberts did a movie on it called 'Charlie Wilson's War.' And so, here you have the United States arming and training the Taliban because the Soviet Union is the enemy. Well, who was one of the Mujahideen fighters that we were arming and training?

FRANK:

Osama bin Laden

BILL:

And he starts al-Qaeda. And you see that it's us propping up. And so, nobody believes that the Taliban could "surprise us" and take the largest military base between China and Europe by surprise, and then having all of our military just leave. I talked to military people that said they

saw Chinese planes flying in while our planes were evacuating people out. I had an Uber driver one time, and he had an accent. I said, where are you from? He goes, Afghanistan. I was a Blackhawk helicopter pilot trained by the Americans, fighting with the Americans against the Taliban. He says there was only 1000 of them that came in and we could have taken them out so easy. We had all kinds of missiles and javelin missiles. And he said they had just motorcycles.

And he said, we got an order from somebody at the top to stand down. And he said, my helicopter pilot buddies landed their helicopters in Tajikistan, because they knew if they landed in Afghanistan, the Taliban would kill them. He said, I had to hide for my life for 10 days. And he said, finally, I was able to contact my trainer in America, and he pulled some strings to get me out. And he goes, now I'm driving an Uber and working at Panera. He goes, I'm an educated man. I got my wings. But he said, yeah. They were saying they didn't want foreigners in Afghanistan. He goes, now China runs Afghanistan. And the military personnel that were guarding, you know, power plants and water plants, they're guarding the same plants but now for the Chinese. It was basically, Biden's gift to China for rare earth metals, for lithium batteries for cars or whatever. But we gave them Afghanistan.

But then you have Jimmy Carter giving all of Iran to the Ayatollah. But then you have an interesting thing. So, from 1980 to 1988, is the Iran Iraq War. Now, Iran's controlled by the Ayatollah. We don't want them to win. And so, you have Ronald Reagan and Rumsfeld, and we are arming and training Saddam Hussein to fight the Ayatollah and the Iranians. And so, Saddam Hussein was a westernized leader. He's dressing in business suits. He's wanting to be friends with the West. And then you have George HW, who wanted to do his new world order. And all of a sudden, it flipped for him. And then you have Bill Clinton, and you have the Monica Lewinsky scandal is beginning to get news. And he fires some missiles, and the Bosnian Serbian war begins. And Bill Clinton with Operation Brute Force, is funneling arms through Iran to get to the Bosnian Muslims, to fight the Serbian Christians.

And there's even a movie called 'Wag the Dog' with Dustin Hoffman and Robert De Niro, on a president running for re-election involved in a sexual scandal. And they hire a Hollywood guy to fabricate a war in Albania, which happens to border Serbia. And this war, why? For one purpose, to get the headlines off of this president running for re-election. But then you come up to the present. And as you mentioned, arms, \$85 billion worth of arms, night vision goggles, state of the art drones left in Afghanistan. And now these weapons are being sold, and there's no tracking any of them. And it's suspected that they're being used against Israel.

FRANK:

Bill, as a Navy man, myself, I said this before when it happened. But the worst thing a United States president ever did to Americans who were on the ground in a hostile country was what Biden did to our military people and Americans also on the ground, particularly the Americans he left behind. You don't leave people behind when you have the opportunity to get them out. And even if you don't have the opportunity to get them out, you make an opportunity to get them

out. Biden did the opposite. He cut tail. He turned tail and he ran, and he left Americans on the ground. And to show you how unfair and biased our media is, I guarantee you that if Trump was President when this happened, and I have problems with Trump, as you know. But if Trump was the president, right now, CNN and MSNBC would lead every one of their broadcasts off with Day 524 of Americans left in Afghanistan. That's what we'd be hearing. We haven't heard any of that because Biden did it.

And it frosts me to no end, that the Commander in Chief did this to Americans, left them in the hands of the Taliban. And as you're pointing out, not only left people in the hands of the Taliban, but also some of our best weaponry, when all of that could have been evacuated. Even if he wanted to get out, he could have gotten out and taken all that with him, but he didn't. It's a travesty, and nobody's holding him accountable.

BILL:

Yeah, it is one of these things where we think, you know, two sides. There's always three. It's always Chinese Checkers. It's not just plain Checkers where you got two sides. It's Chinese Checkers, where you've got multiple things, all going on at once. And so, there's globalists, and they've got the big picture. They wanted to have destabilizing global crises, health care crisis, climate crises, any type of crises, because that gives them an excuse to usurp power for their globalist goals. And everybody down the level is being used. And so, you have these different Muslim groups. They think that they're going to be somehow benefiting from this. They don't realize that they're just pawns in a bigger picture. But there's no honor among thieves. They each think they're using each other.

But it doesn't make sense until you see it from a globalist perspective. You know, I talked to people who are from Iraq. And there was Chaldean Christians. They were minorities, and they were protected by Saddam Hussein. Saddam had six palaces, and they were staffed by Chaldean Christians. And I talked to some people who were part of those families. And they said that, he didn't really like the Christians, but he trusted him. And he knew that they wouldn't slit his family's throats in the middle of the night. And I met one gentleman who was a Chaldean Christian general under Saddam Hussein. And he was a Chaldean Christian. I said, how did you get to be in there? He says, they trusted me. They knew I didn't have any subversive, you know, goals. And so, Saddam, for all of his faults, felt like he was supposed to protect these Christian minorities.

And then you look at Assyria and Assad. And Syria has six different groups. They had the different Maronite Christians and the different, you know, Muslim groups, and the Orthodox groups. And it was like a balancing act to try to keep them all at peace. And you had John Kerry saying, we just want a little war over there. They wanted to destabilize it. Why? Because they have their globalist aspirations and so forth. But even Assad was giving millions of dollars to Malala, this little bitty Christian town that had existed for thousands of years, and they still spoke Aramaic, the language Jesus spoke until he was forced to pull out and the ISIS people went in.

But you had Hillary Clinton, and she was the Secretary of State. And everybody pretty well knows now that what happened in Benghazi was gun running. And she was taking guns. Even Fox News reported on it. She was having guns that were used to take out Qaddafi in Libya were being funneled over to Syria to take out Assad. And then, you know, she was caught in it. And then she's like, oh, it was a long time ago. And who cares about that?

FRANK:

That's right. What does it matter now?

BILL:

But it is interesting. So, when we abandoned and switched, and we took out Saddam Hussein, we did something that any military historian knows you never do. We dismantled the entire government. We dismantled the entire military. Anybody knows if it's a dictatorship where there's a king, you simply get rid of the one guy and you put in your guy. Even the Bible has the story, right? Josiah dies and his son, Jehoahaz, the Egyptians come in, take him away as prisoner, and they take his brother, Jehoiakim, and put him in. Okay, you're now the king, but you've just got to pay us tribute. You don't go in and dismantle the entire structure.

And so, Dave Kilcullen, former chief strategist in the State Department Office said, there undeniably would be no ISIS if we had not invaded Iraq. In other words, if we would have just got rid of the leader and put in one that's more friendly to us, but we dismantled the whole country and left it in total confusion. Out of that came ISIS. So, a lot of these countries, as you know, would get rid of their fundamentalist leaders if globalists with American money didn't keep propping them up. You know, there's a Los Angeles Times article. And it said, "In Syria, militias armed by the Pentagon, fight those armed by the CIA." We're literally doing this critical race theory, getting the two sides to fight each other, creating this internal dissension.

And it was so bad that Tulsi Gabbard introduced a bill called Stop Arming Terrorists Act, March 13, 2017. And Rand Paul introduced the bill in the Senate. And then finally Trump gets in, and Time Magazine had an article. It said President Trump ends covert plan to arm Syrian rebels. So here, we were arming the bad guys. And so, that's why there's concern, as you mentioned, of the arms we left in Afghanistan in the hands of the Taliban. Are they being used against Israel? And then you have Ukraine. There is no accountability for anything we're giving Ukraine. And then it's coming out that it's money-laundering. That whenever you see millions of dollars and billions of dollars go to third world countries, the corrupt leader gets to keep a part of it, and the rest of it gets funneled back to the Clinton Foundation and all these different Democrats in America.

I saw a cartoon in Bidenomics. It says, the government taxes the people. The government sends the money to Ukraine. Ukraine sends the money to Hunter. Hunter writes the check to the dad. Bidenomics. And so, when Hillary Clinton was Secretary of State, guess what the poorest country in Europe was? Ukraine. Guess what the number one country giving money to the Clinton Foundation was? Ukraine. Poorest country in Europe giving the most. Where are they

FRANK:

Follow the money, ladies and gentlemen. Follow the money. Well, Bill, we could keep going. I do have to say one other thing, because since we are talking about Israel and this dispute that's been going on forever. By the way, ladies and gentlemen, a lot of people hated the Jews long before 1948. That's not the issue. It goes back to jihad, it goes back to Wahhabism, it goes back to Muhammad, it goes back to the Quran. So, this has been going on for 1400 years. But I will say this, even though Israel has an ancient claim to the land, that doesn't mean Israel is always right, or that Christians should blindly support Israel when they are wrong. In fact, the history of Israel in the Bible shows Israel repeatedly being punished by pagan nations, and even thrown out of the land because Israel was disobedient.

So, we still have to hold Israel accountable for what they do. It doesn't mean we blindly support them. But yet, on the other hand, we don't buy into this nonsense that if Israel just gave up land, suddenly all the terrorists would go, oh, yeah. Jews are just fine. Let them stay where they are. I'd submit to you, if Israel abandoned the land there and moved all the Jews to Vermont, Hamas would still want them dead in Vermont. Okay? So, this has nothing to do with land. And so, we just have to be clear about that. 'Son of Hamas.' I've got the book.

BILL:

He knew they were not working with the Jews, and he saw them tortured to death. And he thought to himself, if this is the way Hamas works now, imagine what they're going to do if they ever get into power.
